



THE CHARGE FOR THE RECOVERY OF A DOG WHICH HAS STRAYED IS

£49.50



*But this charge will be reduced to **£25.00** for owners who have agreed to have their dogs fitted with an Identichip.**



The current charge of **£49.50** has been set to bring the City Council's fees in line with charges prescribed by the Environmental Protection (Stray Dogs) Regulations 1992. This charge does not include any boarding fees which are currently £8.00 per day (or part there-of).

*The "Identichip" is a tiny microchip implanted into the dog which can be detected only by passing a special scanner over the dog. The "Identichip" system stores the details of all pets on a national database which greatly increases the likelihood of reuniting dogs with their owners.

Animals which are identichipped and have NO PREVIOUS HISTORY OF STRAYING will be returned to their owners free of charge on the first occasion they are uplifted.
