

Kingswells Bucksburn Link

Public Consultation

Aberdeen City Council has received representations from the communities of Bucksburn and Kingswells requesting the creation of a link between the two areas for non-motorised use. The Neighbourhood Community Action Plans for both Kingswells and Bucksburn, developed following extensive public consultation, identify a need for better walking and cycling links between the two communities.

Last year the Council began to consult key Stakeholders on the possibility of providing a new or improved walking and cycling route between Kingswells and Bucksburn. Following this consultation, route options were identified and their feasibility assessed. From this process two possible route corridors have been identified. We would now like to gather the views of the wider community on the route options.

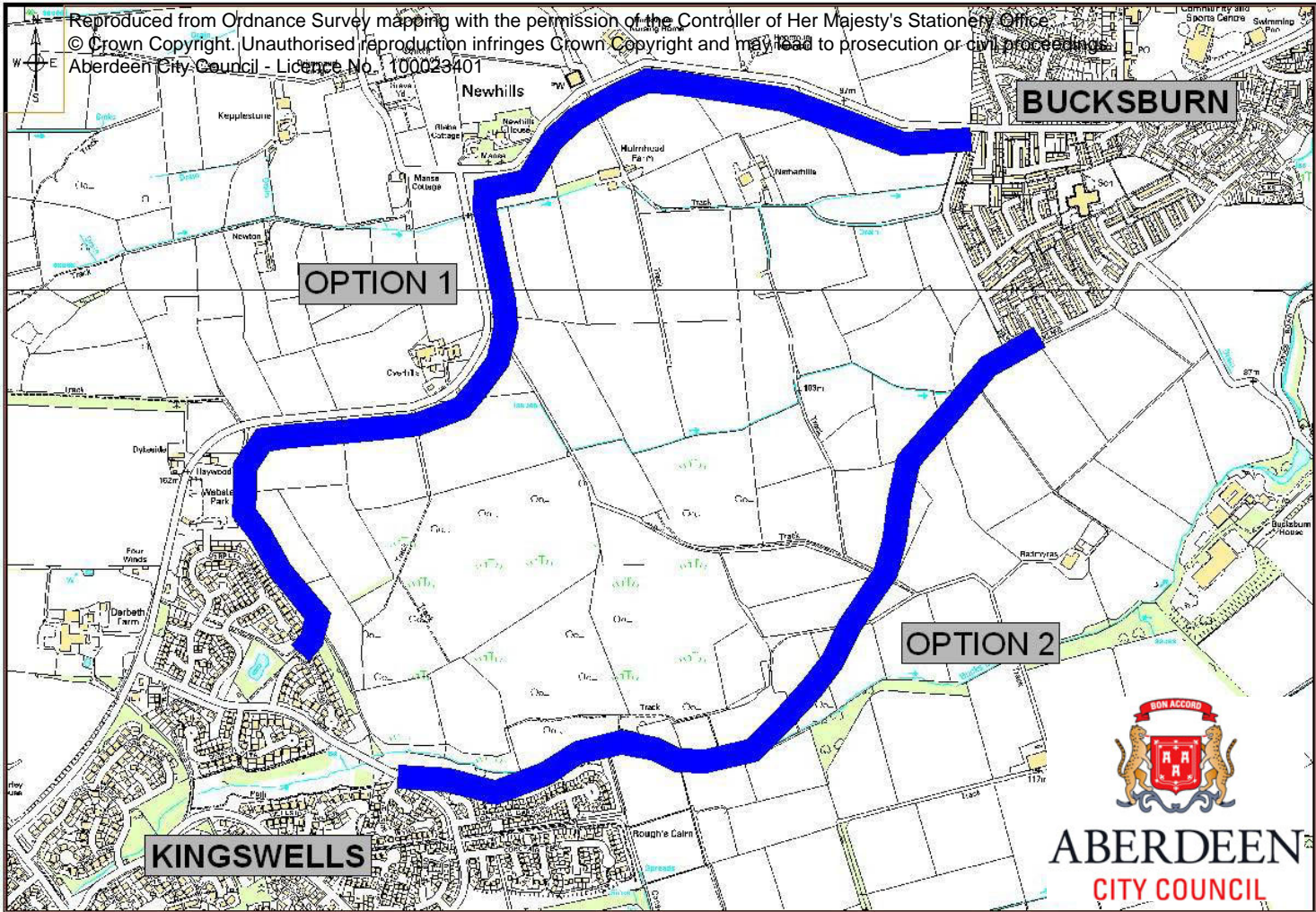
Two options are being presented for public consultation and are shown on the map printed on the back of this leaflet.

Option 1 Is a completely new path following alongside the Newhills road.

Option 2 Is a mixture of new and upgraded existing paths crossing farmland.

The Council would like your opinions on all aspects of both routes from directness and hills to lighting and landscape.
