OBSERVATIONS/ACTION REQUIRED

The purpose of the visit was to undertake a food hygiene inspection in respect of the above legislation.

At the time of the visit all items and areas listed in the report of visit summary were inspected and or discussed and all food safety management documentation and associated records assessed.

From observation and discussion with the cook it was noted that all items and areas highlighted previously have been addressed and documented food safety management procedures fully implemented [following the Cooksafe system]. All hazards are being effectively managed and checks monitored and recorded on a daily basis or as required. All records checked were in order. Advised to replenish stock of bactericidal detergent otherwise all satisfactory. In terms of the Food Hygiene Information Scheme the premises have achieved a Pass once again, therefore, well done to all on all the hard work undertaken. Keep up the food work.
