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I live in Banchory-Devenick and strongly oppose the proposed development by Comer Homes Group.

The greenfields, forest and open natural areas around Banchory-Devenick are beautiful, full of wildlife and a stunning entrance to Aberdeen from the south and across the river in the north and west. The rural community has a small primary school and houses dotted amongst single track / narrow roads with limited infrastructure or public transport. To build a housing development would not only take away from the green belt but would also require a significant upgrade and rethink on the strategy for transport in the area. The local Primary School would not be large enough to cope with a significant increase in pupils.

We walk the paths around Tollohill every week with our children and the wildlife is abundant. Any development would take away habitats and lessen the diversity in the area. The green belt is also the breath of fresh air for Aberdeen ensuring CO2 is captured and turned into O2.
