The revised SPP has changed the wording in relation to the protection of playing fields etc, by referring to the protection applying to 'outdoor sports facilities' (see para 226 of the SPP) which is then defined in the glossary to it. To be consistent with this it would make sense that the LDP uses similar wording.

What change would you like to see made?

Make reference to 'outdoor sports facilities' instead of 'playing fields'/'sports pitches' and include the SPP definition of 'outdoor sports facilities' in the glossary to the LDP.



What would you like to say about the issue?

The site contains two full size pitches and also appears to have changing accommodation. The site is allocated in the LDP however the policy position outlined in Policy NE3 should also apply.

What change would you like to see made?

We note the reporter's findings in the previous LDP, which was that the provisions of policy NE3 would also apply to allocated development sites. If this remains the intention then the policy protection in the SPP in relation to outdoor sports facilities applies, if it is not we would request that reference is made in the Plan to the need to compensate for the loss of the facilities.

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
