#### STATUTORY CONSULTATION

Proposal: To Remove Dual Zoning of the Former Victoria Road School Zone and Define Tullos and Walker Road Schools' Zones

#### 1. BACKGROUND

The Policy and Strategy (Education) Committee took the decision on 29 April 2008 to close the Victoria Road School and make its in-zone area a dual zone for Tullos School and Walker Road School. This meant that residents of the area could choose to send their children to either school. This decision was aided with the fact that both Tullos School and Walker Road School are in the Torry Academy Associated School Group (ASG).

- 1.1 This proposal seeks to remove the dual zone element and define the zones for Tullos School and Walker Road School. The current school zones for Tullos School and Walker Road School are shown in Appendix 1. The proposed re-allocation of the dual zone is shown at Appendix 2. The proposed zones for Tullos School and Walker Road School are detailed in Appendix 3 of this document.
- 1.2 There are two areas that have been identified as potential housing development sites. The former Victoria Road School site has had no specific housing development plans brought forward for consideration by the Council to date. The Waterfront at Tullos has planning permission in principle for 69 flats. Both development areas would be within the area which would be zoned to Tullos School should this proposal be implemented, following public consultation.
- 1.3 The forecasted rolls of the two schools are detailed within the table below.

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<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Projected pupil rolls take account of birth rates, new housing developments and placing requests to and from a school. This data is a best estimate based on the available information at the time of calculation.

- 1.5 Officers are mindful of the increase in pupil rolls at Walker Road School, and the impact this will have on the school building's ability to accommodate the projected increase in the pupil roll. A review of the accommodation is being conducted to assess what changes can be made to accommodate the expected increase in pupil numbers. This will be reported at the earliest opportunity.
- 1.6 The following information details the pupils attending Tullos School and Walker Road School, as 30 January 2014, and provides details of those who are not resident in the schools' zones.

The table tables show that a significant number of children from the former Victoria Road School zone attend Walker Road School and this is creating capacity pressure for the school being able to accept further pupils from outwith its revised zone.

- 1.7 Following the review of the primary school estate, which was reported to the Education, Culture and Sport Committee on 7 February 2013, this proposal is one element of a coordinated approach to manage the pupil numbers at Tullos School, Walker Road School and other schools across the city.
- 1.8 The proposed amendment to the in-zone areas of Tullos School and Walker Road School would have no significant financial implications.
- 1.9 It should be noted that the enrolment of pupils currently attending either of the schools would not be affected by this proposal.

#### 2 EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS

- 2.1 The proposal to remove the dual zoning of the former Victoria Road School Zone from August 2015 will have the following benefits:
  - Families who live in the affected area will have clear information on their zoned Primary School, thereby providing a degree of certainty which is not present at the current time;
  - Ensure that pupils attending either school will be taught with peers from their respective communities;
  - Ensuring that each school has a sustainable pupil roll which delivers the full breadth of Curriculum for Excellence, with a sustainable and viable pupil roll;
  - A sustainable roll will ensure that effective teacher staffing levels are maintained and led by a range of promoted teaching staff. Effective year group classification will be maintained and children will be able to learn within a variety of peer group opportunities, both formally and informally. This will promote a greater understanding of other peers within the wider cohort.
  - The proposals will ensure that both schools have a clear and distinct association with their local communities which should promote and further develop the already strong links with local communities.

#### 3 OPTIONS FOR CONSULTATION

The options under consideration and for which the Council seeks comment from interested stakeholders are:

- (i) To retain the status quo and continue the dual zone arrangement which gives where parents from the former Victoria Road School in-zone area the ability to send their children to either Tullos School or Walker Road School; or
- (ii) Remove the dual zone arrangement and define the zone areas for Tullos School and Walker Road School as per Appendix 3 of this document, with effect from the start of the academic session 2015/16 in August 2015.






