As you may be aware, Aberdeen City Council is proposing to re-zone the former BP Head Quarters part of the Stoneywood School catchment area to Dyce School and consequently from Bucksburn Academy to Dyce Academy

A period of Statutory Consultation is scheduled for 13 January – 28 February, 2014 (inclusive), a total of 32 school days.

The period of public consultation must last a minimum of thirty school days.

In 2014, Friday 14 and Tuesday 18 February are In Service Days and Monday 17 February is a holiday when the schools will be closed and are therefore excluded from contributing to the requisite number of days in the period of consultation.
