### 1. Introduction

Bòrd na Gàidhlig welcomes the initiative to establish a school catchment areas for Gaelic Medium Education Provision (GME) in Aberdeen City.

The Statutory Guidance on Gaelic Education and the National Gaelic Language Plan 2018-23 form the basis for the Bord's response to this consultation. The Statutory Guidance, where there is further detail on the steps involved, has as its basis that GME should develop and grow.

#### 2. Consultation Information

Aberdeen City Council says they want to establish a catchment area for the following reasons:

- GME provision in Aberdeen was established by the former Grampian Regional Council, and at the time no catchment areas were established for this provision.
- Bòrd na Gàidhlig issued Statutory Guidance in 2017, specifying that local authorities should create catchment areas for GME.
- GME within Aberdeen City Council is currently provided at Hazlehead Academy and Gilcomstoun School. To comply with the statutory guidance, it is proposed that catchment areas for these provisions

- That the new catchment areas should take effect from 1 August 2023.

# 4. Statutory Guidance on Gaelic Education

The Statutory Guidance on Gaelic Education recommends that catchment areas are established for schools where Gaelic-medium education (GME) is provided (Section 2.53 & 2.54).

# **GME Catchment Areas and Placing Guidelines**

Education authorities should establish catchment areas for GME provision and may wish to consider demand for GME when setting guidelines for placing pupils in GME provision.

### 2.54 states:

A catchment area of GME provision should be an area in which the education authority thinks it is reasonable for pupils wishing to receive GME provision to travel to school and should have the potential to attract

The education authority has considered both reasonable travel distance & arrangements for pupils and parents.

The city-wide catchment area for both Hazlehead Academy and Gilcomstoun School will ensure GME is both more accessible and more attractive to prospective parents & children.

The education authority has given due consideration to children & families that may be impacted by the proposed changes. For example, those outwith city boundaries, and highlighted that they will be able to continue with GME.

The education authority has highlighted how children & families living outwith city boundaries can access GME should they wish to do so.

Therefore, Bòrd na Gàidhlig welcomes the recommendation that a catchment area will be established for both Hazlehead Academy Gilcomstoun School where there is GME provision.
