Statutory Consultation on the proposal to rezone northwest part of Scotstown School Delineated (Catchment) Area to Greenbrae School and consequently from Bridge of Don Academy to Oldmachar Academy

As you may be aware, Aberdeen City Council is proposing to change some of the zoning arrangements relating to Scotstown School.

The proposal is to rezone the northwest part of the Scotstown School catchment area located to Greenbrae School from August 2014.

As a consequence, the secondary school for that area would also change from Bridge of Don Academy to Oldmachar Academy.

A period of Statutory Consultation will run from **4 November – 18 December, 2013 (inclusive)** which exceeds the statutory period of thirty school days.

A statutory Consultation Document will be made widely available, including at local schools and on the Council web site.
