CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982

CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO WINDOW CLEANER'S LICENCE

- 1. The licenceholder shall, immediately on receiving his licence and before commencing work as a window cleaner, sign his licence in the space provided thereon.
- 2. The licenceholder shall at all times whilst he is engaged in the work of window cleaning, have with him his licence and the badge of indentification issued by the licensing authority and he shall exhibit his licence, on demand, to any person. The badge of identification issued by the licensing authority shall include a recent photograph showing a true likeness of the licenceholder and he shall display his badge of identification at all times while so engaged conspicuously on the outer front, upper portion of his outermost garment with the inscribed badge clearly visible. The licensing authority shall require from the licenceholder, at the time of issue of his licence and badge of identification such sum as may be specified from time to time by them.
- 3. The licenceholder shall not in any way alter, deface, sell, pawn, transfer or otherwise dispose of his licence, or badge, nor shall he in any way alter, erase, lend or transfer his licence or badge. He shall not have or use the licence or badge issued to any other licenceholder.
- 4. Every licenceholder shall, at all times, obey the orders of any police officer given for the purpose of preventing accidents or obstruction or annoyance to any person or persons.
- 5. Every licenceholder shall have in force during the period of his licence and shall satisfy the Council that it is in force, such a policy of insurance as will cover liability to the extent of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Pounds in respect of death or bodily injury of any third parties killed or injured or damage to property caused or contributed to by any act of or accident to the licenceholder or any person employed by him and in addition if appropriate, such a policy of insurance as will cover liability in respect of the death or bodily injury of every person employed by him.
- 6. The licenceholder shall maintain his equipment in good order and repair at all times and shall take all reasonable steps to prevent accidents and to ensure that his activities do not cause injury or annoyance to any person or persons.
- 7. The licenceholder shall ensure that any person who is employed by him as a window cleaner in the City of Aberdeen is in possession of a valid window cleaner's licence issued by the Aberdeen City Council.
