Who is A.C.E for?

Anyone who is currently living at home with social work support, with friends or family in kinship care, with a foster carer, in a children's home or anyone who has previously lived in any of these but has now left care up to the age of 26.

Your Rights

Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously. This right applies at all times, for example during immigration proceedings, housing decisions or the child's day-to-day home life. – UNCRC Article 12

Every child must be free to express their thoughts and opinions and to access all kinds of information, as long as it is within the law. – UNCRC Article 13
