Contest Name

Bridge of Don Ward

I declare that the result of the election in the Bridge of Don Ward is as follows.

There are 4 councillor(s) to be elected.

The percentage poll was 49.3%. There were 7,236 valid ballot papers and 114 rejected ballot papers.

The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected is 1,448.

The first preference votes received by each of the candidates and the stage at which any candidate was elected is as follows:
