Thank you for your information request of 1 November 2017. Aberdeen City Council (ACC) has completed the necessary search for the information requested.

We would be grateful if you would provide us with the undernoted information relative to the east side of Station Road, Bucksburn, Aberdeen between the junction with Mugiemoss Road and the Junction with Old Meldrum Road, Aberdeen.

We would be grateful if you would provide us with:

· A copy of all correspondences regarding the construction of a new footpath on Station Road, Bucksburn, Aberdeen between Aberdeen City Council, WM Donald and Barratt Homes between 1st January 2016 and 1st June 2017;

Please refer to the attached documentation <u>EIR-17-1615 – Document 1 – EIR-17-1615 – Document 8</u>.

ACC is unable to provide you with information on **names, job titles, direct contact details and car registration number** as it is excepted from disclosure. In order to comply with its obligations under the terms of Regulation 13 of the EIRs, ACC hereby gives notice that we are refusing your request under the terms of Regulation 11(2) in conjunction with Regulation 11(3)(a)(i) — Personal Information - of the EIRs.

In making this decision ACC considered the following points:

ACC is of the opinion that Regulation 11(2) applies to the information specified above as the information in question is personal information relating to living individuals, and the applicant is not the data subject.

ACC is of the opinion that Regulation 11(3)(a)(i) applies, as ACC considers that disclosure of this information would be a breach of the first Data Protection Principle (that personal information must be processed fairly and lawfully). The individuals named in the correspondence would not expect ACC to release this information about them into the public domain under the EIRs (or the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA)).

· A copy of the plan for the construction of the new footpaths on Station Road completed by Aberdeen City Council and Barratt Homes Ltd;

Please refer to the attached documentation. Please note that personal data has been redacted under Regulation 11(2) of the EIRs. Please refer to the response above.

· A copy of the repair request made by Aberdeen City Council to WM Donald regarding Station Road, Bucksburn, Aberdeen.

ACC is unable to provide you with information on **a copy of the repair request** as it is not held by the Council. In order to comply with its obligations under the terms of Regulation 10(4)(a) - Information Not Held - of the EIRs, ACC hereby gives notice that this information is not held by it. ACC is required by Regulation 10(1)(b) of the EIRs to inform you as to why in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining this exception outweighs the public interest in disclosing this information to you. ACC is satisfied that it does not hold this information and considers that, as there is no information held, the public interest lies with the exception.

With regard to the above project and further to the site visit undertaken, we confirm that we have reviewed the situation at the existing industrial bellmouth, and attach a copy of our drawing 93688/9051 which indicates our proposal to improve the existing situation.

This proposal allows for the proposed footpath to fall at a gradient of 1 in 30 towards the back of the footpath, rather than falling at 1 in 40 towards the road channel, altering the fall in this manner reduces the level difference from the back of the footpath kerb and the existing yard level which in turn allows the access gradient to be a lot more manageable.

We appreciate that this proposal result in a small portion of the footpath draining into the yard, however this was the situation previously and the situation would still be better than previously as there would have been an area of the road draining into the yard area rather than a small portion of the footpath.

The surface water runoff from Station Road would drain along the road channel where there will be a bull-nosed edging kerb and drain via the road gullies provided.

Can you please review the attached drawing and confirm if these proposals are acceptable.
