

Thank you for your information request of 22 November 2017. Aberdeen City Council (ACC) has completed the necessary search for the information requested.

Please supply all recorded information (e-mails, letters, both internal and to and from 3rd parties, notes from telephones calls, memos, diary entries, agendas and minutes of meetings, any reports or other written material) to No. 15 High Street, Old Aberdeen held by the Development Management Department (including Master planning, Design and Conservation Section) in the period from 25 October 2017 to 21 November 2017 excluding correspondences with Old Aberdeen Heritage Society and the ones which are publicly available on the Planning website pages for applications ref: 170709/LBC and 170710/DPP. Please see enclosed.

Please note that third party names and personal details, as well as the names of ACC Officers who are below Head of Service level have been redacted (blacked out) from the enclosed documents. This is because ACC considers that this information is excepted from disclosure. In order to comply with its obligations under the terms of Regulation 13 of the EIRs, ACC hereby give notice that we are refusing your request under the terms of Regulation 11(2) in conjunction with Regulation 11(3)(a)(i) – Personal Information - of the EIRs.

In making this decision ACC considered the following points:

ACC is of the opinion that Regulation 11(2) applies to the information specified above as the information in question is personal information relating to living individuals, and the applicant is not the data subject.

ACC is of the opinion that Regulation 11(3)(a)(i) applies, as ACC considers that disclosure of this information would be a breach of the first Data Protection Principle (that personal information must be processed fairly and lawfully) and second Data Protection Principle (personal information must ANGELA SCOTT

only be processed for a specific and lawful purpose). ACC Officers who are below Head of Service level and third parties named within the attached document would not expect ACC to release this information about them into the public domain under the EIRs (or the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA)).

Apologies for the delay in responding, I was off sick yesterday.

I can confirm that the applicant has now amended the proposal to omit the beer garden element of the proposal, and the description has been amended accordingly. A amended Site Plan has been received and uploaded into the public domain to reflect this. We are still awaiting further plans on detailed changes to the interiors of the listed building.

Given the level of material change to the original proposal, and taking into account the level of public interest, the Planning Service has decided to re-notify all neighbours and the Community Council tomorrow - as well a place a further advert in the Aberdeen Citizen next week - to provide the opportunity for further comment or withdraw previous comments. Once the period of public comment has expired, the Planning Service will know the timescales and method of determination. It is most likely no decision will be made until next year.

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I refer to your client planning and listed building consent applications for the proposed Public House at 15 High Street, Old Aberdeen.

The 14th November deadline has now passed and I am yet to be in receipt of the required drawings (which were promised in your email dated 06/10/17) to move these applications forward, most drawings of which I requested over 3 months ago. The only drawings I have sought updated since then is the Site Plan to omit the beer garden proposals which would not take very long to do in itself.

The Community Council and Old Aberdeen Heritage Trust are chasing the Council for updates but the Council are unable to provide any such updates on the progress, procedures and timescales for determination until the Council is in receipt of the requested applications. As such, this delay is only providing even greater uncertainty over the future of the building to the wider public who possess an interest.

I'm of the opinion that if these plans are not with the Council within the next 7 days the Council will have to insist that the applications are withdrawn.

Afternoon ,

As promised last week, I can confirm that senior members of staff within the Planning remit of the Council have now discussed how to proceed with your applications for the pub at 15 High Street. The procedures to bring about a determination of the applications are as follows:

- 1) Require updated Site Plan (showing omission of proposed beer garden) and listed building drawings i.e. internal layout and cross-section drawings;
- 2) Once in receipt of the required drawings, all consultees including the local Community Council and neighbours will need to be re-notified and the application will need to be readvertised (this is likely to mean a further £65 advert fee will be due to be paid by you). All existing representations will remain valid unless withdrawn by each individual party who originally made those comments;
- 3) Once the re-notification process has been completed and the Planning Service are content that they have all information and drawings necessary in which to make a determination,

they will seek to make a recommendation at the earliest possible Planning Development Management Committee (PDMC). This would be 18th January 2018 at the very earliest, but more likely to be February. If the application is deferred for a site visit, this would most likely take place a week after the PDMC meeting.

We will need to agree a further extension of time to cater for the re-notification and consultation process, at present I'm proposing the 31st January 2018. Please can you confirm you're happy with this?
