**It would be any action taken under Section 1 of the Act. We are looking for any Acquisition of Land notices that are still on going at the moment, basically we are looking for any that have been served and have not been agreed and settled as yet.**

**When answering in the negative to the above, we would be obliged if you would confirm that you are doing so.**

**Wherever possible we would be grateful if the information could be prepared to include the following:**

- **reference numbers.**
- **addresses of the subjects the actions are served over.**
- **summary descriptions of the nature of the works/contravention.**
- **relevant dates.**
- **status of the action.**
- **amounts owed to the council (when available).**

Aberdeen City Council is not obliged to disclose the information requested above under Regulation 6(1)(b) of the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004. The information requested is held by the Keeper of the Records of Scotland (i.e. by the National Records of Scotland) and is made available to members of the public for inspection.
