Thank you for your information request of 26 October 2018. Aberdeen City Council (ACC) has completed the necessary search for the information requested. Our response is now detailed below.

**The average number of days between a household registering for a council house and their move in date for a suitable council house for:**

**1. 2010/11**

**a) All households that register for a council house**

The average length of time for all households housed into Aberdeen City Council housing in 2010/11 was 917 days.

**b) All households that include a disabled person that register for a council house**

The average length of time for those households, who stated they had a disability, housed in 2010/11 was 659 days

**c) All households that include a child that register for a council house**

The average length of time for those households, that included a child, housed in 2010/11 as 627 days

**2. 2011/12**

**a) All households that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for all households housed into Aberdeen City Council housing in 2011/12 was 1157 days.

**b) All households that include a disabled person that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, who stated they had a disability, housed in 2011/12 was 1177 days

**c) All households that include a child that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, that included a child, housed in 2011/12 was 796 days

**3. 2012/13**

**a) All households that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for all households housed into Aberdeen City Council housing in 2012/13 was 1050 days.

**b) All households that include a disabled person that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, who stated they had a disability, housed in 2012/13 was 532 days

**c) All households that include a child that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, that included a child, housed in 2012/13 was 776 days

**4. 2013/14**

The average length of time for all households housed into Aberdeen City Council housing in 2015/16 was 949 Days

The average length of time for those households, who stated they had a disability, housed in 2015/16 was 785 Days

**c) All households that include a child that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, that included a child, housed in 2015/16 was 693 Days

**7. 2016/17**

**a) All households that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for all households housed into Aberdeen City Council housing in 2016/17 was 878 Days

**b) All households that include a disabled person that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, who stated they had a disability, housed in 2016/17 was 1267 Days

**c) All households that include a child that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, that included a child, housed in 2016/17 was 682 Days

**8. 2017/18**

**a) All households that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for all households housed into Aberdeen City Council housing in 2017/18 was 816 Days

**b) All households that include a disabled person that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, who stated they had a disability, housed in 2017/18 was 981 Days

**c) All households that include a child that register for and move into a council house**

The average length of time for those households, that included a child, housed in 2017/18 was 618 Days
