

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Aberdeen City Council

Election of Councillors

A by-election is to be held to elect two councillors to Electoral Ward 2 – Bridge of Don.

1. Nomination forms can be obtained from the Election Office, Aberdeen City Council, Town House, Broad Street, Aberdeen, AB10 1FY, telephone 01224 523501 and from www.aberdeencity.gov.uk/byelection . This office is open for the delivery of nomination papers on weekdays from Friday 16th August 2019 between 10am to 4pm.
2. Completed nomination forms must be delivered to the Returning Officer at the above address by 4pm on Monday 2nd September 2019.
3. A by-election will be held and voting will take place between 7am and 10pm on Thursday 3rd October 2019.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen, AB16 5GE by Tuesday 17th September 2019.

Postal or proxy voting

1. Any elector may apply for a postal or proxy vote at this election.
2. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen, AB16 5GE by 5pm on Wednesday 18th September 2019.
3. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen, AB16 5GE by 5pm on Wednesday 25th September 2019.
4. Applications to amend or cancel existing proxy arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen, AB16 5GE by 5pm Wednesday 18th September 2019.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of a medical emergency that will prevent a voter from going to the polling station or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Woodhill House, Westburn Road, Aberdeen, AB16 5GE by 5pm on Thursday

3rd October 2019. The medical emergency must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 25th September 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 25th September 2019.
