Thank you for your information request of **10 April 2019**. Aberdeen City Council (ACC) has completed the necessary search for the information requested. Our response is now detailed below.

Please can you provide the following data for each of the past five years for your local authority area:

ACC does not formally arrange any car share schemes. The Council is a member of the Getabout Liftshare scheme, funded by Nestrans, and encourages employers throughout the city to operate their own scheme or participate in the Liftshare scheme, however, ACC is not involved in the formal establishment or operation of these schemes.

ACC is unable to provide you with information on **how many car share schemes did the local authority formally arrange by year** as it is not held by the Council. In order to comply with its obligations under the terms of Regulation 10(4)(a) - Information Not Held - of the EIRs, ACC hereby gives notice that this information is not held by it. ACC is required by Regulation 10(1)(b) of the EIRs to inform you as to why in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining this exception outweighs the public interest in disclosing this information to you. ACC is satisfied that it does not hold this information and considers that, as there is no information held, the public interest lies with the exception.

INFORMATION ABOUT THE HANDLING OF YOUR REQUEST

As the information which you requested is environmental information, as defined under Regulation 2(1) of the Environmental Information (Scotland) Regulations 2004 (the EIRs), ACC considered that it was exempt from release through FOISA, and must therefore give you notice that we are refusing your request under Section 39(2) of FOISA (Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002). However, you have a separate right to access the information which you have requested under Regulation 5 of the EIRs, under which ACC has handled your request. Please refer to the attached PDF for more information about your rights under the EIRs.
