We do not hold this information. Our Consultation Model delivers some direct work negotiated school by school, most work upskilling school staff on identification, assessment and support strategies. This model tries to impact on the greater number of children through supporting those working directly with the child i.e. class teachers; although individual children receive direct support, where there are multiple and complex factors affecting their learning and development.
