I will now declare the result of the election in the Tillydrone-Seaton-Old Aberdeen Ward. There are 3 Councillors to be elected

The electorate was 8,872 and the number of ballot papers received was 2,727 giving a percentage turnout of $30.7 \%$. There were 111 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 655.
