## Declaration of Results

This report is the Declaration of Results script for Returning Officer.

I will now declare the result of the election in the Bridge of Don Ward. There are 4 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 15,216 and the number of ballot papers received was 6,930 giving a percentage turnout of $45.5 \%$. There were 137 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 1,359 .
