




SUPPORTING EMPLOYABILITY

CREATIVE EMPLOYABILITY PROGRAMME

Creative Learning deliver one to one sessions or small group creative workshops, enabling and empowering Young People (15-25), who are not in education or employment, to improve their personal and employability skills.

We work with young people who have an interest in art & design, practical making, photography, digital media or generally identify as being interesting in anything creative.

Workshops build on the young person's interests and skills, creating a portfolio of work, assisting them to move towards an application to further education, training, or employment...
