How to Cross a Shared Cycle Track



Crossing a continuous shared cycle track from a sideroad

Pedestrians & cyclists have priority. Vehicle drivers must give way to anyone on the track.

Once the track is clear, the driver can then proceed across and wait until the road is clear to make their turn.
