



WORKING WITH PEOPLE SUSTAINING LIFE AS A CREATIVE

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME

Creative Learning commissioned Glasgow CAN to deliver their Participatory Arts Short Course (PASC), a unique vocational training programme. We collaborated to develop a bespoke offer tailored to the needs of the ten individuals signed up to the professional development programme.

The programme was delivered as a hybrid model where Creative Learning supported ten individuals through both mentoring and the allocation of small Bursaries. This resulted in 21 workshops taking place during the summer of 2023, engaging with 58 participants and working with 7 different partners..
