YOUNG AMBASSADORS







Aberdeen City Council's Creative Learning team are recruiting **Freelance Creative Practitioners** with experience of using creative processes to engage and consult with young people on innovative planning projects.

Building resilience, confidence, and creative learning skills, the practitioners will support the development of a group of Young Ambassadors leading to the presentation of a a youth led engagement event during the Aberdeen Easter Holidays 8 – 12 April 2024.

Young Ambassadors Programme Outline:

This project will initially run from March 2024 - April 2024 to deliver a youth led event during the second week of the Aberdeen School Easter Holiday 8- 12 April. It is anticipated that the development of the Young Ambassadors will run beyond this period. Sessions will be weekly, with intense support and delivery between 8 - 12 April.

The Programme will take place at The Beach Ballroom in Aberdeen.

You will be working to develop the Young Ambassadors group, providing artist-led training and skills development, supporting the group to connect with other youth led initiatives in the city and supporting the delivery of UNCRC Article 12 through an interactive creative process.

Outputs for participants:

- A participatory youth led event .at Aberdeen Beach Ballroom.
- Knowledge of event design and presentation.
- Live work experience





Creative Practioners Role:

Creative Practitioners role will include:

- Developing and growing the young ambassadors group
- Delivering on UNCRC Article 12 to ensure outcomes are met.
- Contribute to project evaluation, documenting sessions and exploring creative ways to collect experiences and impacts .
- Share project plan for each week, with relevant project team in advance, identifying themes and activities.
- Maintaining an environment that is safe and welcoming for participants throughout project
- Maintain relationships with CCBMP partners to ensure relevant and purposeful communication

Fees:

Freelance Creative Practitioners Fee:

- Lead Artists 8 days @ £200 per day = £1600 total fee.
- A small materials budget will be available for Easter project

Application:

We are keen to hear from creative practitioners who have experience of using arts based approaches to consult with young people on innovative planning projects. Artist should have a good understanding of current large scale planning projects in Aberdeen. Artists are required to demonstrate a working knowledge of UNCRC Article 12.
