Thank you for your information request of 28 February 2017. Aberdeen City Council (ACC) has completed the necessary search for the information requested.

Please could I request an up to date list of all contractors, subcontractors and suppliers that have or will be involved with the Aberdeen Western Peripheral Route - Northern Leg?

While our aim is to provide information whenever possible, in this instance Aberdeen City Council does not hold some of the information you have requested. Therefore, ACC is unable to provide you with a complete project directory as it is not held by the Council. In order to comply with its obligations under the terms of Regulation 10(4)(a) - Information Not Held - of the EIRs, ACC hereby gives notice that this information is not held by it. ACC is required by Regulation 10(1)(b) of the EIRs to inform you as to why in all the circumstances of the case, the public interest in maintaining this exception outweighs the public interest in disclosing this information to you. ACC is satisfied that it does not hold this information and considers that, as there is no information held, the public interest lies with the exception.

I can confirm that the principal contract for the AWPR/B-T project is between:

- Aberdeen Roads Limited and Aberdeen City Council

The two principal subcontracts Aberdeen Roads Limited holds are with:

- AWPR Construction Joint Venture comprising Balfour Beatty Civil Engineering, Carillion Civil Engineering and Galliford Try Infrastructure trading as Morrison, for the design and construction of the New Works required under the AWPR/B-T Project; and
- Balfour Beatty Regional Civil Engineering, for operation and maintenance of relevant roads included within the scope of the AWPR/B-T Project.

Also involved with Aberdeen City Council for design and build aspects of the AWPR/B-T project:

- Engineering advisory services provided by Jacobs Engineering Group and SWECO UK.
