Thank you for your information request of 10 June 2016. Aberdeen City Council (ACC) has completed the necessary search for the information requested.

**This is a Freedom of Information request regarding 20mph limits in the council area. Can you please provide, for each of the 20mph roads in the area, the number of accidents and casualties for each of the years from 2005-06 to 2015-16.**

**Can you please provide the same figures for each of the 30mph roads in the area.**

**Where a road had a 20mph limit introduced within this time period, please provide the number of accidents and casualties for each of the years where it was 20mph and each of the years where it was 30mph – clearly identifying please which years had which speed limits.**
