Thank you for your information request of 7 February 2017. Aberdeen City Council (ACC) has completed the necessary search for the information requested. Please accept our apologies for the delay in responding to your request.

**I am looking for data that shows places in Aberdeen city where people park and lock their bicycles (bike racks).**

**It would be helpful if I could get the information in the form of a GIS layer or shapefile.**

Aberdeen City Council does not have a full inventory of cycle parking in Aberdeen City.

Attached, however, are some files that show the location of some cycle parking, which were developed as part of a previous research project. It should be noted however that the information is incomplete and has not been verified by Aberdeen City Council. In particular:

- This information is not exhaustive – the exercise did not include the outlying suburbs, hence why no information is provided on areas such as Milltimber, Peterculter and Kingswells;
- The researcher was only able to map the cycle parking that he was able to view and access. Parking within private grounds and enclosed curtilages, such as offices and schools, is therefore not included.

It should also be noted that all usage of this information should reference Gameli K. Agboada, University of Aberdeen, who developed the existing cycle parking database as part of a Master's degree research project.

We hope this helps with your request.
