Please accept our sincere apologies for the delay in responding to your information request of 13 March 2017. Aberdeen City Council (ACC) has completed the necessary search for the information requested.

These questions relate to money to be repaid by pupils for Accord Card-style cards since its rollout across the city. Please provide a breakdown for each school.

- 1. How many pupils have been loaned credit on the cards?
- 2. How many pupils still owe credit?
- 3. How much is owed in total at each school?
- 4. What are the three largest amounts of credit owed at each school?
- 5. Please state when the system was brought in at each school.

Please note, ACC do not provide or loan credit on Accord Cards.

In relation to money owed on Accord Cards, please see the attached sheet.

In secondary schools, approximately £1.2 million is loaded to the Accord Card each year to spend at the schools catering facilities. Very occasionally, pupils may not have money in their catering 'account' to pay for lunch and the school will, of course, loan monies on a temporary basis to ensure they can get something to eat.

In primary schools, we have a duty of care to make sure that each pupil has lunch. We work with parents and carers to maximise the uptake of free school meals and support them in any way possible to ensure they receive their entitlement and take the appropriate action where monies are due.

ACC is unable to provide you with information on **loaned credit** as it is not held by ACC. In order to comply with its obligations under the terms of Section 17 of the FOISA, ACC hereby gives notice that this information is not held by it.
