I am the team member who uses the electronic mapping system to create the images and uploads the images to the website. Unfortunately I have been on leave until today and was unable to respond to your email which you submitted last week. It would appear that the information held on the mapping system indicating the education land property boundaries for Stoneywood had not been updated and when inserted in to the map did include your private property. In order to correct this information I have manually drawn the site boundary item on the map and created an image which better matches the current land ownership position. The appendix 2

item has been updated in the document and replaced on our website along with a note both on the web page and within the document itself indicating the changes made today. As we have used a scale which allowed those concerned to identify the surrounding area actual details are not that apparent. These changes are not material to the proposal being made within our document and will have had no impact upon our consultation process and I hope that the new version meets with your approval.

In the event that the proposal proceeds and a decision is reached to create a new school on a different site, the future use of the existing site would then fall to the Aberdeen City Asset Management Team rather than our team who deal only with day to day items on operational Education and Children's Services premises and have no input as to future uses of sites no longer operating as schools etc. We would be unable to advise on any timescale or communication which may than take place.
