Dear Sir,

I wish to object to the proposed redevelopment on the site of Braeside Infant School on the basis that the proposed development of the site represents an overdevelopment of the site and is likely to involve the loss of a valuable amenity to the area. Whilst it is appreciated that the Council may consider that the needs of the community are now adequately served by the provision of infant schooling at Airyhall, the loss of the Braeside site as a potential alternative is something which the Council may well live to regret. Furthermore, the proposed development of the site (presumably for housing) will cause extensive disruption and inconvenience to surrounding proprietors over an extended period of time and is likely to lead to the loss or erosion of the adjacent play area which admittedly is not part of the footprint of the proposed development but will have an impact. In the circumstances I would be grateful if you would acknowledge this objection as co-proprietor of adjacent subjects at 6 Braeside Place, Aberdeen.
